The Practice- A 5 to 6 days workshop is conducted in the college for the students of Education Semester III. A proper timetable of all the methods to be taught is prepared along with the names of the supervising teacher. It is to acquaint and make student- teacher's better equipped with new methods and techniques of teaching learning ,their use and to enhance the learning and creativity of the student-teachers in the field of teaching

The most common techniques and methods dealt are KIM, Chronologue, WH template ,mind maps, Jig-saw, educational games ect.

Everyday one or two methodology are worked upon. This is done in three phases

1. The method is elaborately explained by the teacher .
- 2.The students vigorously practice on them in groups or as the teacher guides.
3. Each group gives a presentation in front of the whole class about what they have prepared.

Learning Outcomes

- Students were able to understand the concept of each of the methods and apply them.
- They were able to realize the need and importance of using such tools for teaching learning process. Students were able to incorporate different active methods in their pedagogies.
- Students enjoy learning during workshop. Also ,manifests 'learning by doing.'

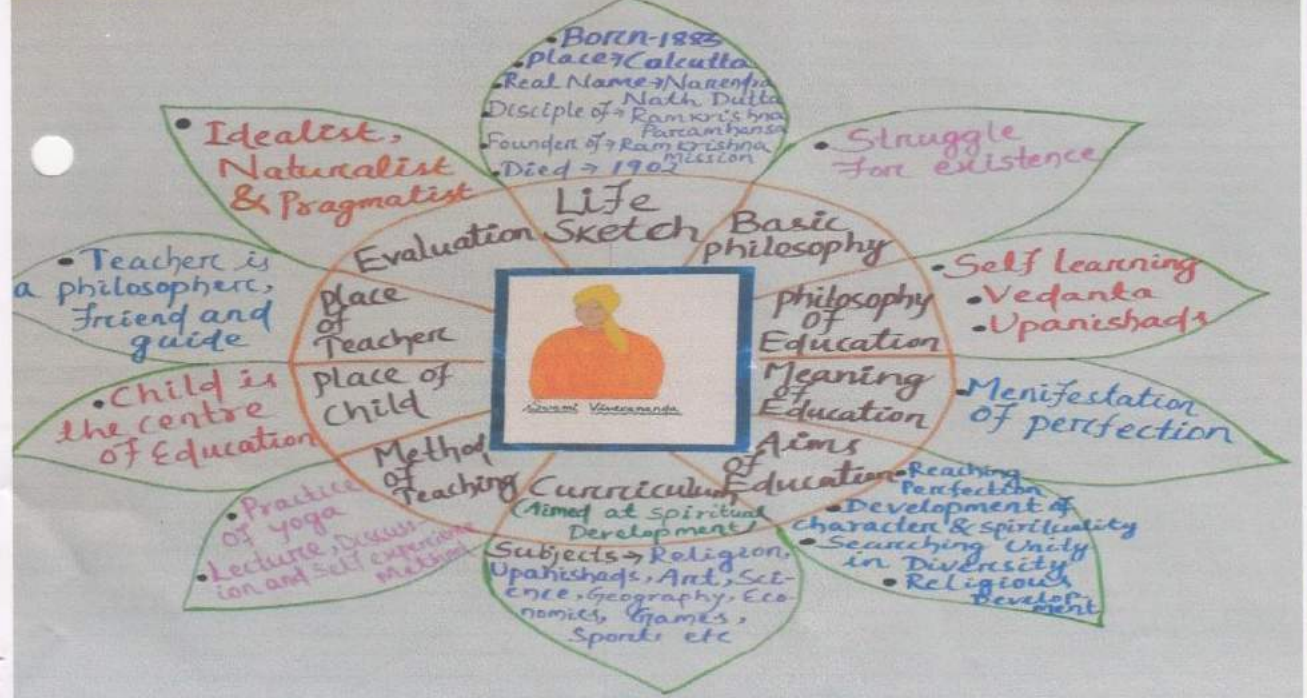
