

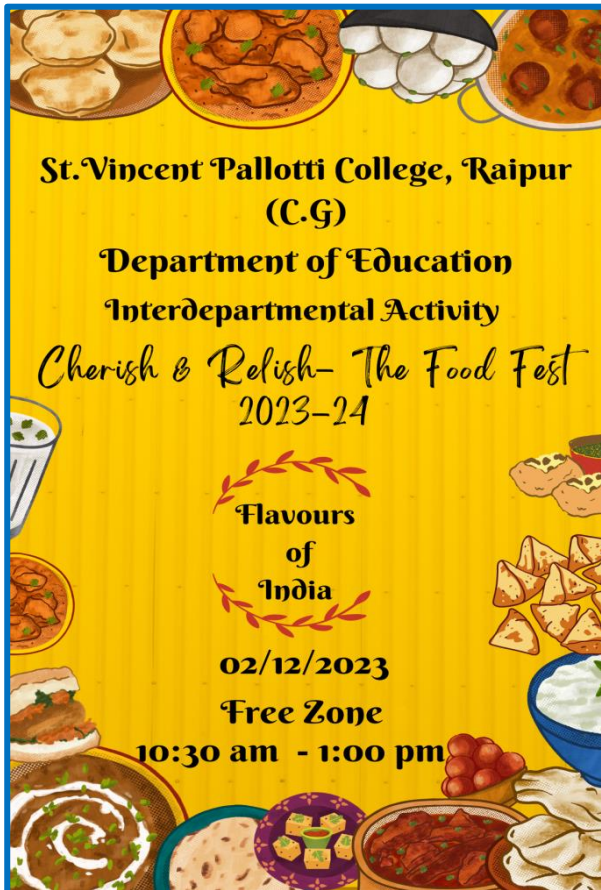

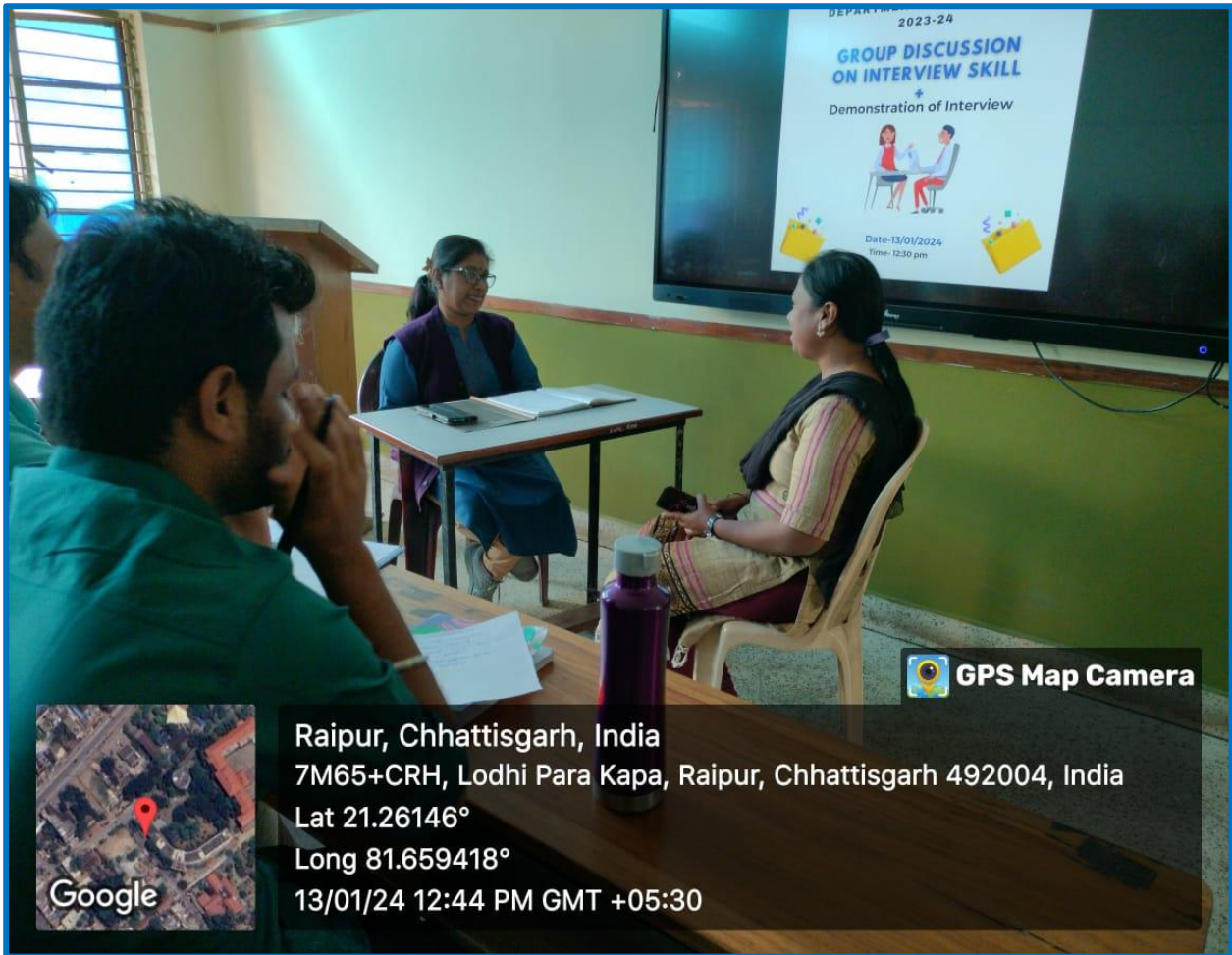
1. Interactive classes on language and communication skill.
