## **ABOUT COLLEGE**

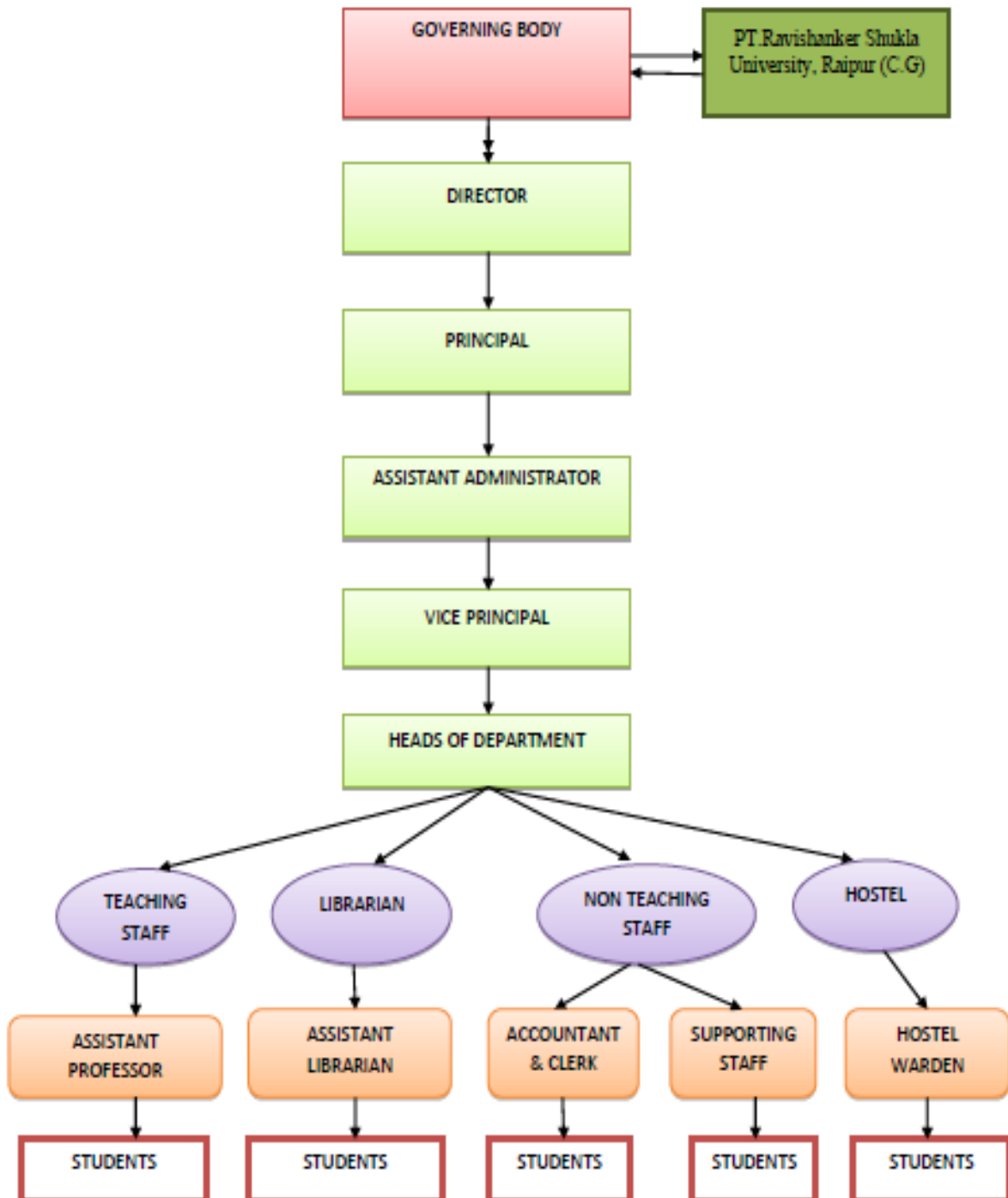
