

BEST PRACTICE 2: Learning beyond the Classroom

7.2.2.1 Title of the practice: Learning beyond the Classroom

7.2.2.2 Objectives of the Practice

- 1. To cultivate an atmosphere of sharing of knowledge among the Students.
- 2. To motivate the students to update themselves endlessly that in turn leads to modernize their knowledge.
- 3. To enhance the soft skills as presentation, exposition, technical specialities, mastery over giving interview and many more.
- 4. To bring cohesiveness among the students.
- 5. To come up with some unique and new concepts so that it will be helpful to students in comprehensive ways.
- 6. To have plenty of interaction among all students and also to learn to give a lots of thought to their audio visual aids.
- 7. To facilitate learning and development among all.

7.2.2.3 The context

St. Vincent Pallotti College has a number of departments having skilled and experienced faculties. The progressive culture of the college demands continuous updation of information in various fields. To fulfil these requirements, college operates a unique approach to benefit the students. It is known as **'Learning beyond the classroom'.** In this activity, all the departments identify the needs of the students those falls beyond the range of regular syllabus but are essential for their development and vocational justification. This methodology helps in developing some new insights into different commercial, technical, social, moral and cultural issues. The topic ranges from a vast variety of skills as presentation, exposition, technical specialities, mastery over giving interview and many more.

7.2.2.4 The Practice

St. Vincent Pallotti College has a regular practice of conducting such add-on activities since many years. The execution of learning beyond classroom has been one of the best practices of the college and this practice has brought amazing results. The philosophy behind this practice is to see the learning as a continuous dynamic process. The students learn in best way when they are kept engaged in a variety of well-structured activities and this in turn generate great results.

The concept of learning beyond classroom was introduced because such practices allow the educators and the students, to let out their creativity through each relevant opportunity. Students must have impeccable skills sets for piquing the different aspects of their personal and professional life. Every department of the college devotes an exclusive span of time in weekly or monthly manner for these sessions.

To strengthen skills, focus lies on improving skills in these three areas:

- Verbal and Non-Verbal Communication.
- Effective use of the presentation skills and Visual-Aids
- Effective Design and Meaningful Organization of Contents
- To practice the technical skills sets.

The success of a teaching session is dependent on multiple factors, including adequate preparation, the balance of learners' needs with educational goals, active participant learning led by a skilled facilitator, and appropriate assessment of the session's educational outcomes.

Following are the main thrust areas of various departments in this context:

Commerce Department:

a. Explore in Career designing and Interior Decoration Opportunities

On 20th of October 2022, the department has organized a 'One Day Workshop' on the 'Exploration of Career Alternatives and Add-ons in the Interior & Fashion Designing Courses'. The workshop is mainly dealt with two aspects (i) the alternative courses to be opted along with B.Com graduation (ii) Enhancing the creative skill-set. Mr. Harsh Dubey, the chief co-coordinator and speaker of the institute has emphasized and provide the important information on the present-day features and developments of future-ready courses viz., 'Interior Designing' and 'Fashion Designing'. Mr. Vishnu, a contemporary fashion designer has been carried out an activity on 'Abstract Art' with respect to the identification of the students' creative abilities and application in order to pave the way for obtaining their respective courses.

b. Nick of Time

"Nick of the Time" comprises a group of activities related to time management, team building and decision making. The students of B.Com-I, II&III have participated in a variety of games and events viz., (i) Pyramid making by disposables (ii) Balloon challenge (iii) Creative wear (iv) Singing and Dancing performance this learn with fun activity was organized on 27/08/2022 by the department.

Department of Education:

a. ALM Workshop

A seven days ALM [Active Learning Methodology] workshop was organized by the Department of Education from 12/7/2022 to 19/07/2022 for the students of semester III. The workshop was very fruitful for the students. It was to acquaint and make student -teachers better equipped with new methods and techniques of teaching- learning. It helped the students to enhance the learning and creativity in the field of teaching. Students worked in groups. The techniques and methods dealt were Chronologue, WH-template, Mind mapping, Educational games, Sloke- Sutra, Cloze test, Database questions, Quiz etc. The workshop was very beneficial and enjoyable for the students. For each technique students presented their work at the end of the session.

c. Training Session on Smart Board

Students become more excited about learning when the smart boards are incorporated into the lesson. Department of Education organized a Smart Board (Brio Touch) Training session for the students of B.Ed semester II & IV to enable students to learn and explore new concepts using technology to create a more dynamic learning experience under the expertise of Mr. Gaurav Gupta. The instructor gave a detailed demonstration of the smart board. The students enjoyed the fruitful training session and also tried their hands on the different features of the smart board. It was a great learning experience for all the students and it will definitely help the teacher-trainees to cope with the technological changes and incorporate technology in their teaching effectively.

d. Personality Development

St. Vincent Pallotti College is always keen for exploring different methods for the overall development of personality of its students. In this sequence Department of Education of the College organized 'Certificate course in Personality Development' for the B.Ed. IV semester students from 20.02.2020 to 24.03.2020 .The course included modules like Spoken English, interview skills, resume making, Body language, Communication skills etc. The skill was taught and drilled through various activities by the faculty of the B.Ed. department.

The whole course was accomplished in three phases-

- Interactive classes on language and communication skill.
- Body language and Body Posture.
- Preparation of a Proper resume and Practice of Interview Skill through LBD (Learning by Doing)

The course was concluded with a concluding ceremony .In the ceremony certificates were delivered by the Director and the Principal the college.

e. Relish and Cherish-Food Fest

St. Vincent Pallotti College always aims for the all round development of the students. With the objective of propelling awareness towards healthy and tasty food and inculcating entrepreneurship among students combined with entertainment, a grand healthy food fest 'Cherish and Relish' was organized by the Department of Education on 21 /01/23. The college free zone was filled with colourful stalls, palatable, pleasant aroma of food and cheerful talks and laughter of students. Twenty five stalls with nearly fifty different healthy food items were ready to serve.

The objective of healthy food was successfully achieved as all the items were not only healthy with nutritive value but also highly palatable. Some of them are mixed fruit salad, guava punch-chaat, healthy gupo-chupo, Lassi kesar, duska- chatni etc. The program was inaugurated by the Director of the college, Principal and Vice Principal. Selling and purchasing of food items were through coupons for convenience. All the food items were full of taste and all the students and staff of the college really cherished and relished them.

Department of Computer Science:

a. World Computer Literacy Day

World Computer Literacy Day is observed on 2/12/2022 every year all over the world. Department of Computer Science has celebrated this day by engaging students of BCA-I and PGDCA. 4 Groups of 5 students each from the mentioned classes were formed namely Team PARAM, Team INTERPRETER,

Team TECHNOWLEDGE, and Team the A Team. These teams had visited different classes and departments of the college and shared technical facts and knowledge with them.

b. Flyer making competition

Department of Computer Science organized Flyer Making Competition on the topic "Admission Open in St. Vincent Pallotti College" to improve the technical and creative skills of the students on 26/11/2022. Students were using <u>Canva</u>, Adobe Photoshop, In design, Coral Draw, and Pics Art for designing their own flyers. The students beautifully created the flyers using various software. A total of 10 students from all the classes participated in the competition. The time duration allotted to participants was 45 minutes to completely create the flyer.

c. Techno Updation-II

Computer technology is very volatile in nature and it is getting updated very quickly so it's really necessary to update ourselves as well. So the initiative was taken by the Department of Computer Science and organized an event on 19/10/2022 named 'Techno Update-II' where students were able to share their knowledge about new technologies. The aim of this activity was to develop relationship with current technologies.

d. Computer Hardware Maintenance

Department of Computer Science has organized a 5 day Workshop on Computer Hardware and Maintenance for BCA students from 28th Nov - 2th Dec 2022 in association with GLOBAL Computer Institute, Raipur. Mr. Pramod Pal, Director, Global Computer Institute has given the training to the students in the workshop. Objective of this workshop was making students aware about the internal organization of computer system and internal structure of CPU. Mr Pramod Pal sir also taught how to take care of the computer's physical components, such as its keyboard, hard drive, BIOS setting and installation of software. 7.2.2.5 Evidence of Success

7.2.2.6 Problems encountered and resources required:

Report

The Active Learning Methodology Workshop was conducted from 12/07/22 to 19/07/22. Participants

Workshop Agenda

The instructor gave a detailed demonstration of the smart board. The students enjoyed the fruitful training session and also tried their hands on the different features of the smart board.







Mr.Tiwari explained the basic concepts of stock market, Forms of business are Sole Proprietary firm. Pattnership Firm, Private Ltd companies and Public Ltd companies. Capital can also be collected through debts. Stock market is a place where two types of people come together one who needs funds for business and other who have excess fund and want to invest in business. He also explained about the how share market is divided into two parts and its busic concepts like; Frimary Market: IPO, FPO, Offer for sale takes place. Secondary Market is where sellers and tuyers come together through e-platform to trade the shares and earn money.

He further explained about the transaction at stock market through flow chart. He logged in the portal which showed live status of buying and selling of shares at secondary market. Various reports generate through the portal, with some examples he showed the demo how trading takes place. How documentation takes place, when you buy shares. Industrial visits provide a welcome opportunity for us, management students away from the grueling academic sessions and rushing deadlines to gain a hands on experience of a plant functioning. Continuing the tradition, the department of management organized the industrial visit for the current academic sessions for the whole BBA IV semester at Jindal Steel & Power Limited Raipur Plant. The visit was scheduled from 02.03.2023.

JSPL Raipur Plant is located 13 km from Raipur and operates as the machinery division. The plant is spread over an area of around 162000 m2 and manufactures critical equipment such as cranes, pressure vessels, ladles, and other steel castings used in steel, power, cement, and mining industries. The visiting batch of the students was given a brief introduction about JSPL and the machinery division by a panel of marketing, operations and safety managers of the plant. This was followed by a guided tour of the facility in small groups. The plant is divided in four units based on the processes such as casting, forging, machining and assembly. Students were briefed about the functioning of various machinery and production processes. The small groups facilitated increased discussion. It was an exciting experience for students of non-engineering background to see the manufacturing processes, involving big muchines and molten steel.
