The college is located in Kapa,Raipur,C.G. The college offers degree courses such as B.Com,, BBA,B.C.A.,B.P.E. Post Graduate courses in Commerce, English and PGDCA and Yoga arealso offered to the society. The dedication of the management and the community, combined with excellent infrastructural and teaching facilities help maintain high Standards in curricular and co-curricular spheres of the institution.




