

Findings:

- 1. 50% of the students are satisfied and 50 % of the students are not satisfied with the present syllabus.

- 3. 58.16% of students feel that present syllabus provide them vocational skills.
- 4. 63.27% of students are satisfied with the present program they have selected and only 35.71% students are not satisfied.
- 5. 61.22% of students are satisfied that syllabus covers all the subjects required for the higher studies. Only 38.78% are not satisfied.




Employer's Feedback on Curriculum

- 8. 100% of employers are rated as very good on planning and organization.







