

Findings

- 1. 76.55% of the students are satisfied and only 23.4% of the students are not satisfied with the present syllabus.
- 2. 69.23% of students say that they get practical knowledge from present syllabus.
- 3. 63.73% of students feel that present syllabus provide them vocational skills.
- 4. 70.69% of students are satisfied with the present program they have selected and only 27.47% students are not satisfied.
- 5. 70.69% of students are satisfied that syllabus covers all the subjects required for the higher studies. 27.16% are not satisfied.



Findings:

- 1. 17.39% of the teachers are strongly agreed and 69.57% are agreed that syllabus is properly organized and only 13.04% of teachers are disagreed.
- 2. 39.13% of the teachers are strongly agreed and 47.83 % are agreed that teaching learning materials are easily available. Only 13.04 % of teachers are disagreed.
- 3. 26.09% of the teachers are strongly agreed and 65.22% are agreed that learning objectives are appropriate according to the need of the student's. Only 8.70% teachers are disagreeing.
- 4. 34.78% of the teachers are strongly agreed and 56.52% are agreed that syllabus contains required practical knowledge. Only 8.70% teachers are disagreed.
- 5. 56.52% are agreed and 21.74% are strongly agreed that syllabus is job oriented. Only 21.74% teachers are disagreed.
- 6. 30.43% of the teachers are strongly agreed and 52.17% are agreed that syllabus is revised by the university as per the societal need. Only 17.39% teachers are disagreed.






Findings:

Employer's Feedback on Curriculum

- 1. 25% of employers have rated as excellent, 62.50% as very good, 12.50% as good on technical competency of students.
- 2. 50% of employers have rated as excellent and 50% as very good on communication skills of students.
- 3. 25% of employers have rated as excellent, 50% as very good and 25% as good on practical approach of students.
- 4. 37.50% of employers rated as excellent and 62.50% as very good on leadership qualities of students.
- 5. 37.50% of employers rated as excellent and 62.50% as very good on approach towards teamwork of students.
- 6. 12.50% of employers rated as excellent, 75% as very good and 12.50% as satisfactory on ideas and innovation of students.
- 7. 37.50% of employers rated as excellent, 37.50% as very good and 25% as good on syllabus relevance to job profile.
- 8. 50% of employers have rated as excellent, 37.50 as very good and 12.50 as good on planning and organization.






- 2. 26.81% of alumni's have rated as excellent, 42.03% as very good, 18.84% as good and agreed that curriculum helped in the development of overall personality. Only 10.87% of alumni's have rated satisfactory.
- 3. 25.36% of alumni's have rated as excellent, 30.43% as very good, 25.36% as good and agreed that course contents are appropriate according to the need of the student's. Only 15.94% alumni's have rated satisfactory.
- 4. 30.43% of alumni's have rated as excellent, 26.09% as very good and 19.57% as good and agreed that leadership qualities acquired. 23.91% alumni's have rated satisfactory.
