
**Report of two-day Workshop**


On

**“Research Methodology and Quantitative Techniques”**

The Department of Commerce has organized a two-day workshop on “Research Methodology and Quantitative Techniques” for the students of B.COM and B.B.A. The faculty members of the Commerce and Management departments were also participated through Zoom application from **18-12-2020 to 19-12-2020** at 12:00 P.M. The main objectives of the Workshop are (i) To familiarize the participants about the nature of Research Data, the problems and prospects of qualitative and quantitative data (ii) To train the participants in the use of appropriate modes of analyzing quantitative data. The schedule and contents of the workshop were covered as below.

- **18-12-2020 (Day-1)-Research Design:** Head of the Department of Commerce, Mr. Vaibhav Shrivastava explained about the Quantitative research methodology – Problem formulation, research design, methods of data collection and sources of data. In quantitative she discussed descriptive, correlation, causal comparative and experimental. He also discussed about cohort study, pre-experimental design, quasi-experimental design and factorial design. In pre-experimental, he explained one shot case study, one group-pretest-posttest and static group comparison. In Quasi experimental Design, the aspects of non-equivalent control group design and counter balanced design. Mr. Vaibhav Shrivastava also focused on numerical data and narrative data. He also emphasized on the research designs of mixed method study i.e. sequential designs and concurrent designs.
- **19-12-2020 (Day-2)-Research Problem Selection and Research Process:** This session was taken by Mrs. Neetu Gupta, Assistant Professor of Department of Commerce. As a Research Scholar, she has elaborately explained about the identification of research problem, basic assumptions of the data collection and analysis, critical interpretation and validation. Mrs. Neetu Gupta has also highlighted the essential features of Research Proposal, strengths and limitations. She ended the session by re-iterating the purpose of literature review and model for the proposal of the thesis.

**“Computer Hardware and Maintenance”**

Department of Computer Science has organized a 5 day's **Workshop on Computer Hardware and Maintenance** for BCA students from 15<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> March 2021 in association with **GLOBAL Computer Institute**, Raipur. Mr. Pramod Pal, Director, global Computer Institute has given the training to the students in the workshop. Objective of this workshop was making students aware about the internal organization of computer system and internal structure of CPU. Also included was taking care of the computer's physical components, such as its keyboard, hard drive, BIOS setting and installation of software. Hands on practice has also been given to students. Daywise schedule of the workshop was:

- **Day-1:** Mr. Pramod Pal shared knowledge about physical parts of computer like: RAM, Motherboard, CPU, Processor, Hard Disk etc. He explained functions of all these parts and students got the chance to see physical devices inside the system.
- **Day-2:** “How to assemble a PC?” was the theme of second day. Students have been given hands on practice for assembling and disassembling process of the computer system, where the steps were monitored by the instructor.
- **Day-3:** In this session the trainer explained about BIOS. He focused on how to know the status of devices, whether they are properly working or not. He discussed about the BIOS, BIOS types, BIOS setting in detail. Students practically learn how to enter in BIOS setting, make appropriate changes and get information of system from BIOS.
- **Day-4:** Preparation of system for installation of operating system was demonstrated by the tutor, he explained all the necessary steps like: create disk partition, format disk etc.
- **Day-5:** Instructor demonstrated installation process like: selection of boot device from BIOS, bootable disk of operating system, installation options in different steps. He cleared the doubts arose by the students.

The session was ended with the vote of thanks by Mrs. Pooja Rathi, HOD, Department of Computer Science. Students reported that they have got good knowledge and this will be very helpful to solve real life problems. They were very satisfied and have demanded more such workshops in future.
