They include many areas of assessment such as Verbal Reasoning, Numerical Reasoning, Abstract Reasoning and other such abilities. These tests have become really common these days, especially for students who are confused and undecided about their careers.

So, keeping this in mind Department of Computer Science organized an "E- Aptitude Test" for the students of BCA and PGDCA in virtual mode using Google Form. Time duration of 30 minutes was allotted to solve the test. The test was divided into three categories viz Reasoning, Quantitative and English, where each section contained 10 questions each of 1 mark.

Reasoning

Logical Reasoning is a part of almost all major Government exams conducted all over the country and is one of the most scoring sections as well. This section included questions related to Blood Relation, Coding-Decoding, Seating Arrangement, Alphanumeric Series etc.

English

This section included spelling, grammar, and ability to understand analogies. These questions appear in most general aptitude tests because employers usually want to know how well one can communicate.

Quantitative

This section included basic arithmetic, number sequences and simple mathematics. At management level, one will often be presented with charts and graphs that need to be interpreted. These questions appear in most general aptitude tests because employers usually want some indication of one's ability to use numbers even if this is not a major part of the job.

The test was totally based on exam pattern and 52 students responded very actively. Students came to know about their reasoning and logical ability. They were very happy for attending such useful activity.

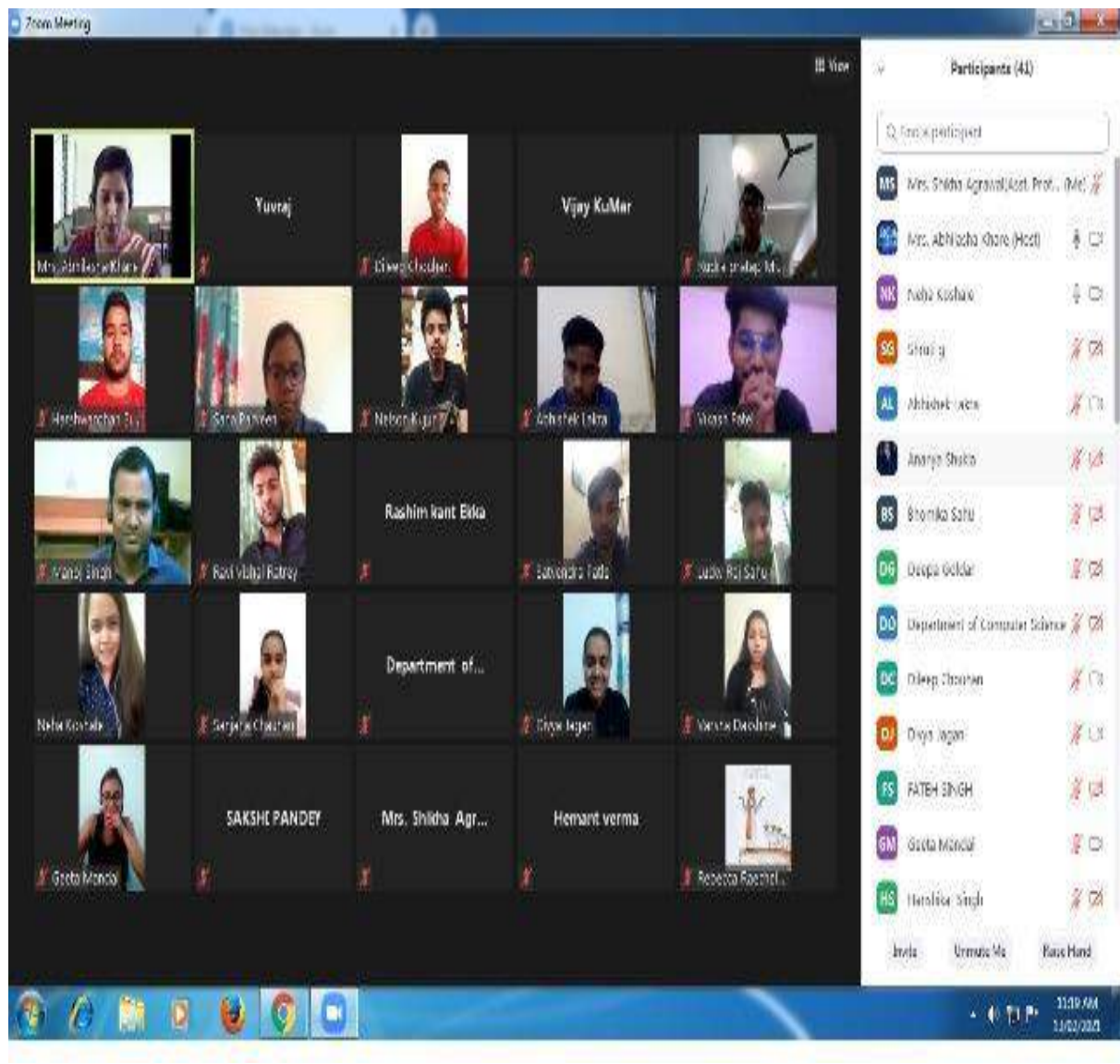
How Brain-Computer Interfaces Work




5 Days Workshop
on

“Computer Hardware and Maintenance”

Department of Computer Science has organized a 5 day's **Workshop on Computer Hardware and Maintenance** for BCA students from 15th-19th March 2021 in association with **GLOBAL Computer Institute**, Raipur. Mr. Pramod Pal, Director, global Computer Institute has given the training to the students in the workshop. Objective of this workshop was making students aware about the internal organization of computer system and internal structure of CPU. Also included was taking care of the computer's physical components, such as its keyboard, hard drive, BIOS setting and installation of software. Hands on practice has also been given to students. Daywise schedule of the workshop was:

- **Day-1:** Mr. Pramod Pal shared knowledge about physical parts of computer like: RAM, Motherboard, CPU, Processor, Hard Disk etc. He explained functions of all these parts and students got the chance to see physical devices inside the system.
- **Day-2:** “How to assemble a PC?” was the theme of second day. Students have been given hands on practice for assembling and disassembling process of the computer system, where the steps were monitored by the instructor.
- **Day-3:** In this session the trainer explained about BIOS. He focused on how to know the status of devices, whether they are properly working or not. He discussed about the BIOS, BIOS types, BIOS setting in detail. Students practically learn how to enter in BIOS setting, make appropriate changes and get information of system from BIOS.
- **Day-4:** Preparation of system for installation of operating system was demonstrated by the tutor, he explained all the necessary steps like: create disk partition, format disk etc.
- **Day-5:** Instructor demonstrated installation process like: selection of boot device from BIOS, bootable disk of operating system, installation options in different steps. He cleared the doubts arose by the students.

The session was ended with the vote of thanks by Mrs. Pooja Rathi, HOD, Department of Computer Science. Students reported that they have got good knowledge and this will be very helpful to solve real life problems. They were very satisfied and have demanded more such workshops in future.

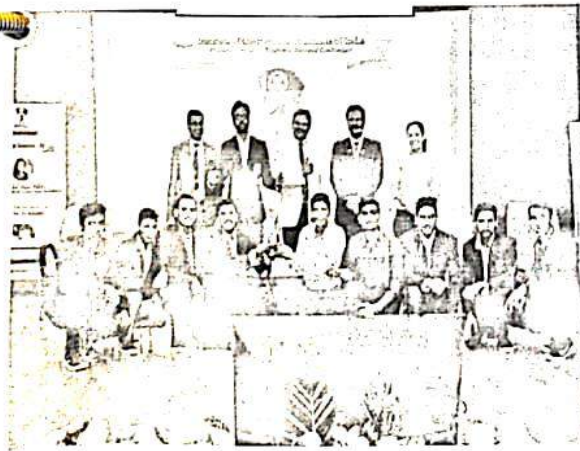


Figure 1 CA Aspirants of SVPC With Principal Dr. Kuldeep Dubey, and CA Atul Agrawal, CICASA Chairman



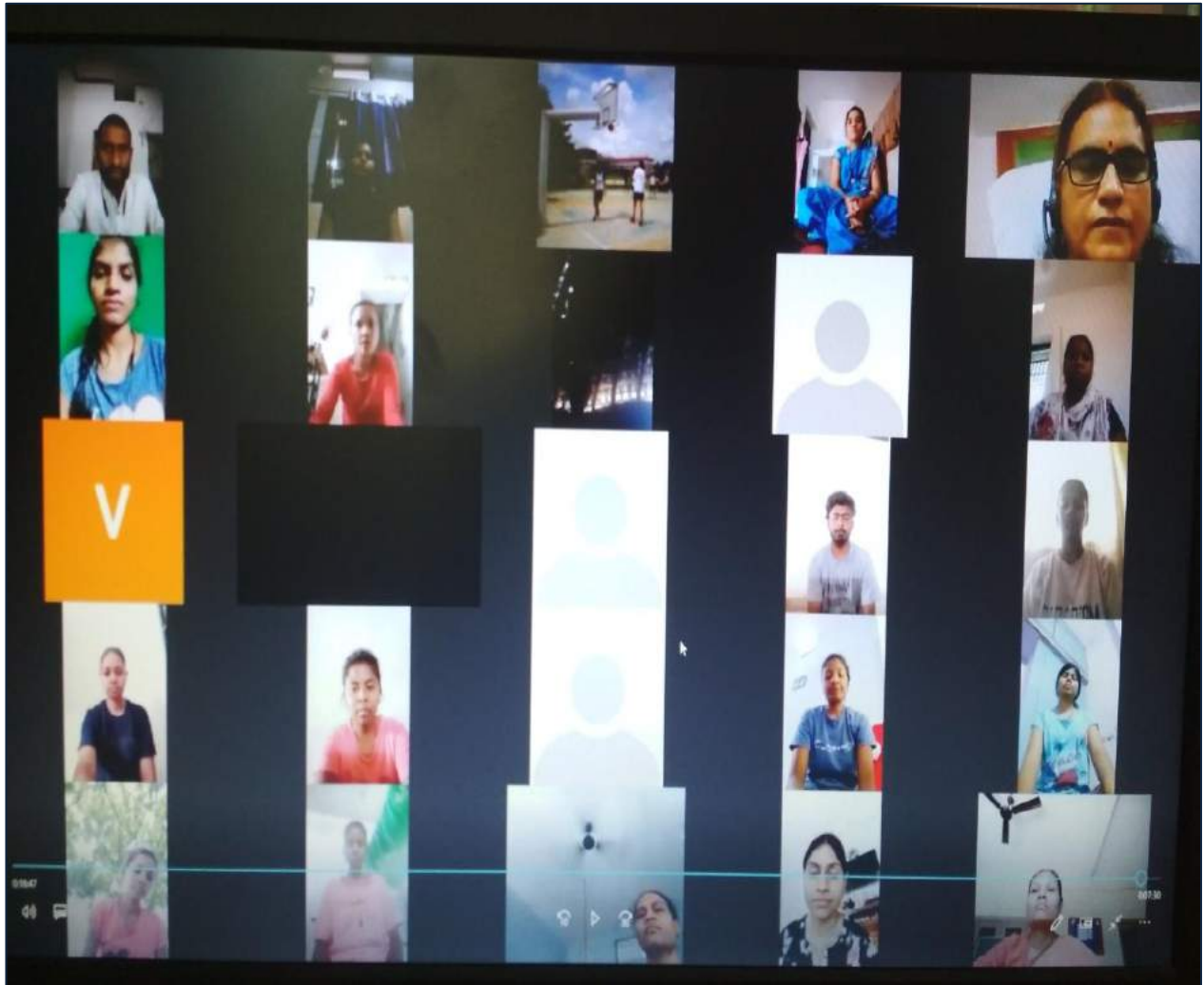


Figure 6- Online Yoga Program - 1-6-2021
