

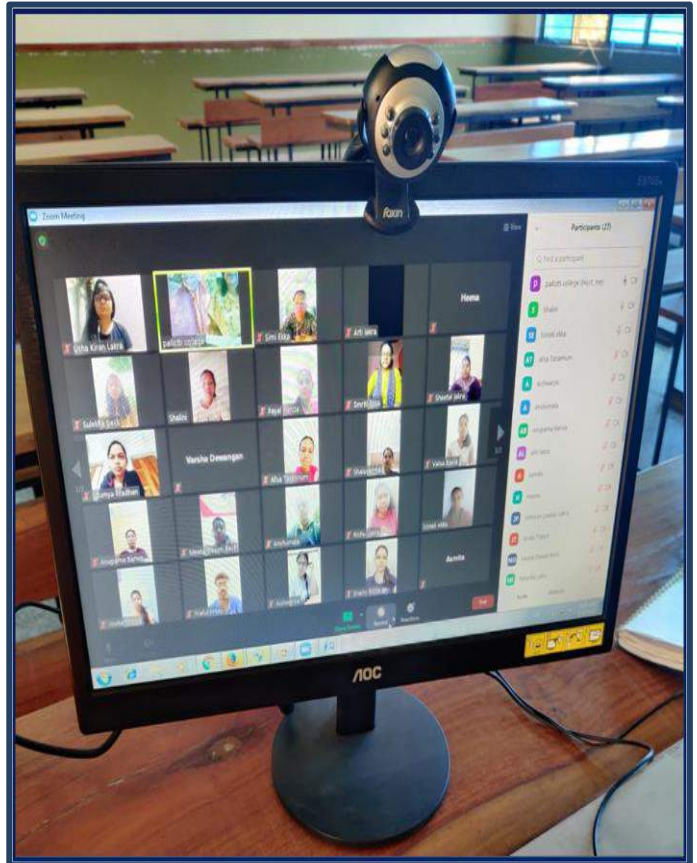
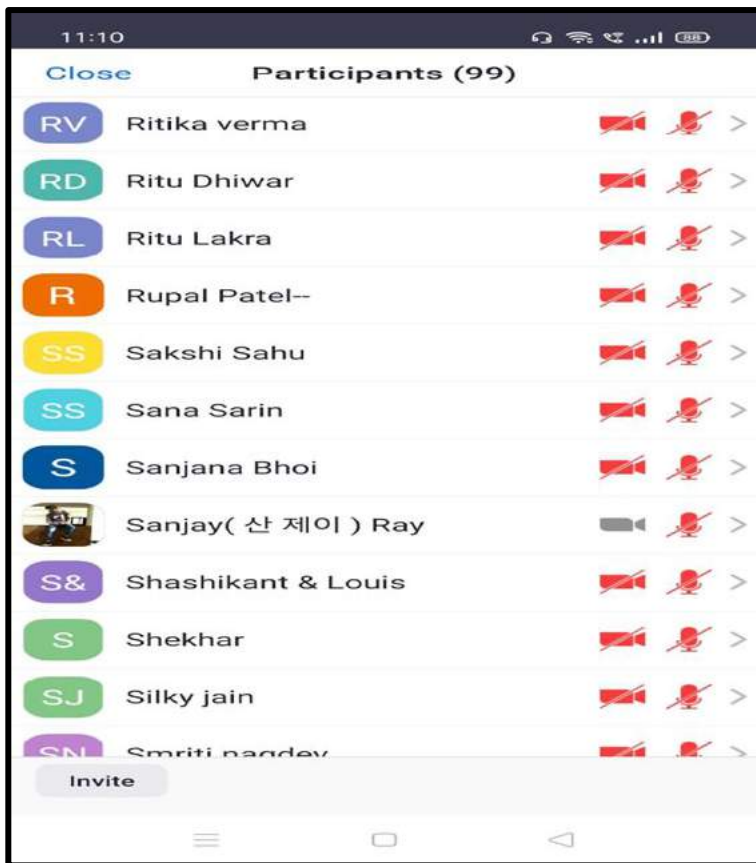
SPECIFIC FACILITIES PROVIDED FOR WOMEN

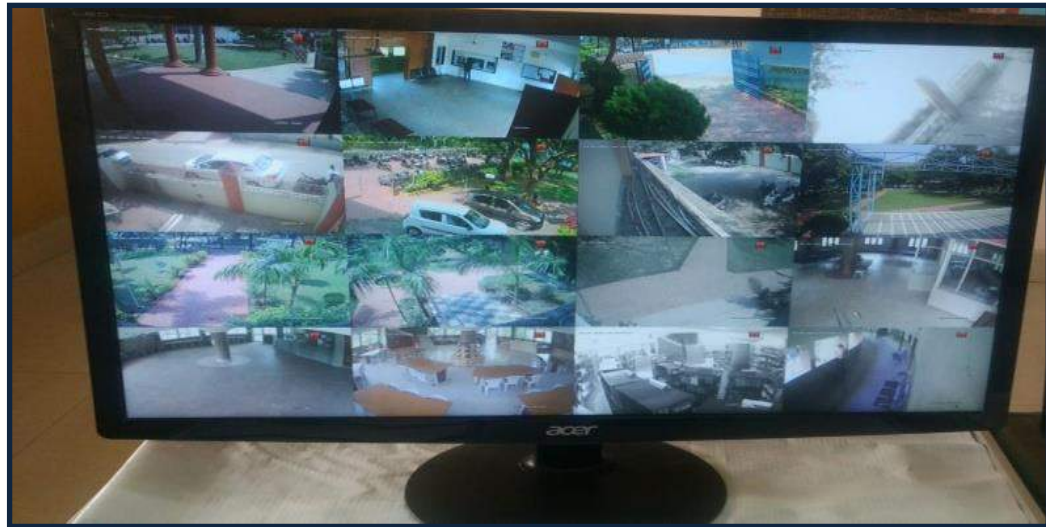
Hostel

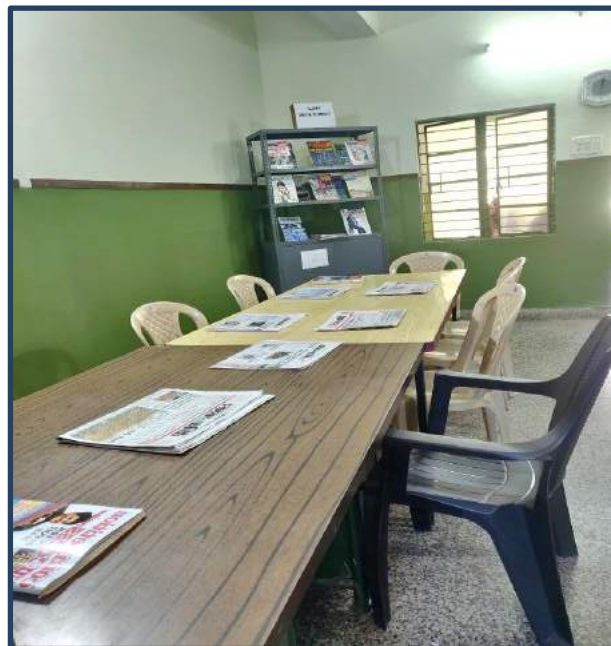
Alter Parent System

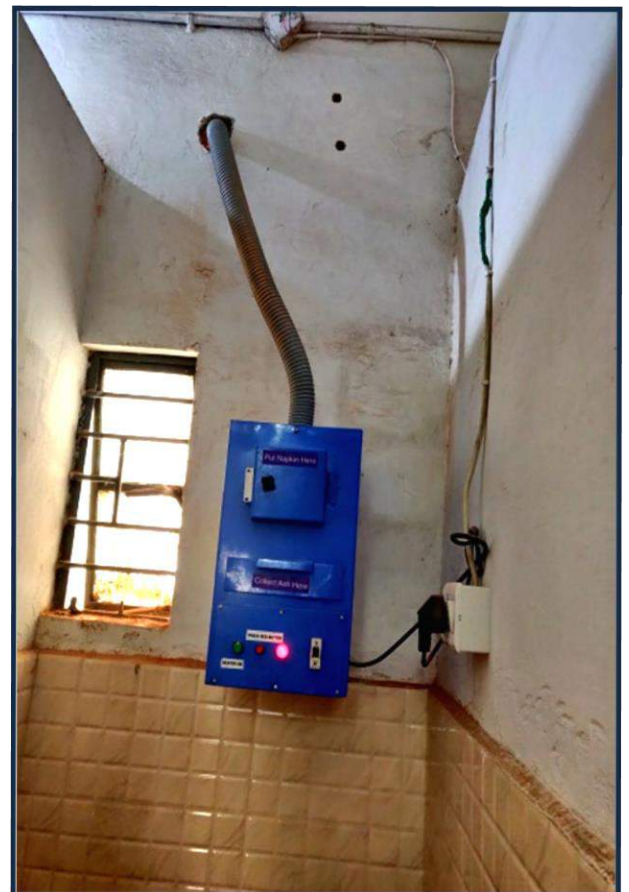


Sanitary vending machine
